7. Be on site at the Vanier Museopark (300 des Pères-Blancs Ave.) at least 10 minutes before the activity begins.

1. Guaranteeing a number of animators proportional to the number of students;
2. Guaranteeing the number of places reserved by the School during the workshop(s);
3. Preparing the activities and the necessary supplies;
4. Be available before and/or after the activities to answer the teacher's questions (any request for a meeting must be made to the Programming Manager).

This contract can only be modified in writing and with the consent of both parties. In the event of the cancellation of an activity by the Vanier Museopark, we will contact the person responsible at the School to ensure a follow-up.
